

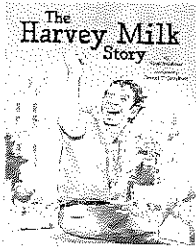

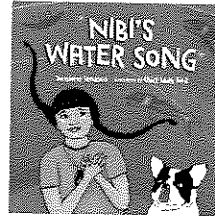

A hopeful and inspiring biography of the historic gay activist Harvey Milk, who gave people the courage to be proud of who they are.



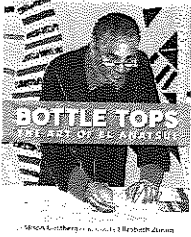
NIBI'S WATER SONG

This bright and vivacious book from two Native creators celebrates the energy, moxie, and determination of water activists of all ages.



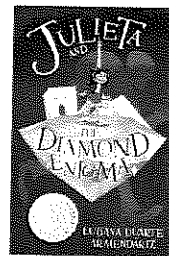
WHERE WONDER GROWS
